GOLF ETIQUETTE

1. Do not play until the players in front are out of range. Players searching for a ball must signal players behind them to pass as soon as it becomes apparent the ball will not easily be found. They should not search for the maximum time of 5 minutes before calling them through and must ensure the players are out of range before resuming play.
2. Please leave the green immediately when play is finished on each hole. Players must not linger on the green to mark their cards or retake a missed putt when other players are waiting.
3. Trolleys/bags should be left as near as possible to the next tee when putting (never on the approach to the green) Players should not have to cross the green to collect their trolleys/bags and double back across the green to get to the next tee.
4. Please tee off promptly at next tee. The person with the honour should not wait to mark the card. Players should proceed as quickly as possible, minimise the time taken between shots, not hole out when the result of the hole will not affect the score and always be aware of maintaining their group position on the course.
5. 'Ready Golf' – in stroke play a player may play out of turn if ready and it is safe to do so, and it would not distract or interfere with another player. Rule 6.4b(2)
6. Think of other golfers before speaking loudly or calling out to other golfers. Players can be easily distracted by unnecessary noise on the golf course.
7. Footprints and other holes in bunkers must be smoothed over or raked before leaving (with the rake provided)
8. Flag sticks should be handled with care so as not to cause damage to the green. Do not stand in any other player's line or nearer the hole than is necessary.
9. All divots on fairways must be replaced and pressed down firmly.
10. Pitch marks on greens should be carefully repaired.

PRIORITY ON THE COURSE

1. Priority on the course will be given to official qualifying club competitions, i.e. monthly medal and stablefords, internal club knock-out matches and inter-club matches; otherwise speed of play will determine the priority.
2. Any group playing a whole round is entitled to pass a group playing a shorter round.
3. The term "group" includes a single player.
4. If a match, other than that identified in (1) above fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one hole, it should allow the match following to pass.
5. No play is allowed off the 10th tee from 1½ hours after the start of a qualifying competition.

JUNIOR SECTION

1. At weekends and on Bank Holidays:
No member of the junior section is permitted to play before noon unless accompanied by a full adult member, or a part of an official junior competition or match taking place that day.
2. At all other times:
 - No junior aged under 12 may play the course except with an adult or a junior aged 14 or over .
 - No junior aged under 14 may play the course alone.
3. Qualification for club championships, see Rule 11, P7.

DRESS CODE

Sutton Green's dress code aims to encourage an informal and relaxed approach in keeping with the atmosphere of the Club. In aiming to create a welcoming environment, members are requested to adhere to reasonable standards of dress and behaviour at all times on the course and in the clubhouse, and with the dress code now favouring smart casual over traditionally formal, some examples of what is and is not acceptable are as follows:

On the golf course and practice area : Golf shoes must be worn; trainers are not permitted. Golf shirts with collars or turtlenecks, men's shirts with sleeves; no T-shirts;.Shorts of an appropriate style (no cargo pants). No denim.

Permitted in the clubhouse: Clean street shoes and trainer-style casual footwear; denim, but not distressed, ripped or frayed jeans; no dirty or untidy clothes; no headgear.

Please refrain from using mobile phones on the golf course or in the clubhouse unless in an emergency, and always with respect for others.

Members are asked to adhere to our smart casual policy, to enable all members, visitors and staff feel comfortable and at ease at the Club.

GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS OF COMPETITIONS FOR ALL MEMBERS

1. All competitions must be played in accordance with the **R & A RULES OF GOLF** and Sutton Green Golf Club's **LOCAL RULES** in force at the time of the competition.
2. Members are not eligible to play in any Competition unless they have a competitive CONGU handicap. Exception : see monthly medals & stableford conditions.
3. Failure to comply with (**RULES 1 & 2**) will result in disqualification.
4. Posters will be displayed giving all necessary details of entry for all competitions.
5. No member may enter for a club competition **after the published closing date.** (Except medals and stablefords).
6. Should any competitor, having entered and been allocated a tee time for a competition, fail to appear without notifying the **Pro Shop (NOT the COMPETITION ORGANISER)** of their inability to play, then they will receive a written ban. This prevents them from participating in all Sutton Green Golf Club monthly qualifying competitions for one month. Fourteen days will be allowed for appeal. Any further breach of this rule within six months will enable the Committee to consider increasing the ban to three months.
7. All competitors must report to the Pro Shop and pay their entry fee 15 minutes before their teeing off time.
8. Players must then report to the tee 5 minutes before their published tee time. If a player arrives late at the starting point the penalty for failing to start on time will be invoked.
 - * **MATCH PLAY: Loss of first hole.**
 - * **STROKE PLAY: Two shot penalty at the first hole.**
 - * **FOURBALL & BEST BALL: See R&A Rule 23.4**
9. Provided there is no course ban in operation, buggies and trolleys may be used in any Club Competition. If a trolley and/or buggy ban is in force at the start of a competition, then the ban will remain in force throughout the competition for that day. (Caddies may be used at any time). Exception: disabled golfers within the meaning of Section 6 of the Equality Act.
10. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature) the player is in breach of Rule 4.3a for which the penalty is: first breach, loss of hole in match play or 2 shot penalty in stroke play, second breach disqualification.
11. Any disputes must be addressed in writing through the relevant Competition Secretary whose decision will be final and binding.
12. **Juniors**

- a) Any junior with a competitive CONGU handicap of 9 or better for boys and 18 or better for girls, or any junior aged 14 years or over with a competitive CONGU handicap, may enter adult club MEDAL & STABLEFORD competitions.
- b) Juniors with a competitive CONGU handicap of 18 or better may enter the club scratch championship.
- c) Juniors are excluded from ALL other full and five day member competitions and knock outs.
- d) Juniors are allowed caddies but they must not be an adult relative, a coach or professional golfer.
- e) Except in an emergency neither received nor sent texts or mobile calls are allowed during play.
- f) Spectators who accompany juniors on the course during any competition must remain at least 20 metres from play at all times, they are not allowed to pull trolleys, carry the golf bag or assist in any way. Exception: for under 10's or when assisting in search of a golf ball.

CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY AND PLAYING MONTHLY

MEDAL & STABLEFORD COMPETITIONS

Medals and stablefords are stroke play competitions scheduled to take place each month. Members with an inactive handicap may play in these to gain a competition 'c' handicap, but will not be allowed to win any prize in the competition, and therefore will not pay an entry fee.

13. Men will play from the white markers, ladies from the red markers.
In mixed competitions the relevant CONGU standard scratch adjustment will be made.
14. There are four **medal** competitions each month
 - a) A monthly weekend medal for men which alternates between Saturday and Sunday.
 - b) A monthly weekend medal for ladies played at the same time as the Men's Medal.
 - c) A monthly midweek medal for ladies on a Tuesday.
 - d) A monthly midweek medal for men on a Thursday.
 In mixed stablefords, ladies' handicaps are to be adjusted to reflect the difference in Standard Scratch Score (SSS). During winter months, stableford competitions may be substituted for these medals.
15. There are three **stablefords** each month.
 - i) A mixed weekend stableford which alternates between Saturday and Sunday.
 - ii) A mixed midweek stableford on a Thursday.
 - iii) A ladies midweek stableford on a Tuesday.
 During the winter months these may be played from the blue tees for men.
16.
 - a) An entry sheet will be posted 4 weeks prior to the date of the competition to notify details of the date, time, entry fee and bans. Competitors may indicate when entering their preferences for an early or late start time within the field. The Competition Organiser will endeavour to meet such requests, **however no guarantees can be given.**
 - b) A draw for starting times will be made and a Starting Sheet posted a minimum of **8 days** before the competition (**5 Days** for midweek) and posted in the **Pro Shop** and where possible on the website.
 - c) All entry & two's sweep fees **MUST BE PAID & RECORDED** to the Pro Shop **BEFORE PLAY.**
 - d) On medal and stableford days, all competitions will start from the 1st tee unless otherwise stated. The tee will be reserved for competitions; the start sheet will give details of timings.
 - e) Score cards must be correctly completed & signed in accordance with R&A rules. Scores should be entered on the Player Score Input (PSI) system & cards placed in the Competition Box provided no later than 30 minutes after completion of your round. Failure to comply with this will result in disqualification.
 - f) Results of Competitions and two's sweep will be posted on notice boards and in Pro Shop with details of prize vouchers
 - g) Non-competitors may play from the 1st tee before or after competition times but must observe the following:-
 - i) No starting within 30 minutes of the times allocated to the first competitors off in the morning or afternoon.
 - ii) Non-competitors must not interfere with the flow of the competition field
 - iii) Non-competitors following the medal/stableford field are not entitled to be called through.

CONDITIONS OF QUALIFYING FOR ALL MAJOR & KNOCKOUT COMPETITIONS

(The Club Championship, Captains' Trophies, The Hillier Cup, The Jamie Cup, The Laura Davies Trophy, The McMullan Seddon Salver, The Olde Tiffin, The Travers Trophy, The Trower Trophy)

17. In order to qualify for entry into any major competition and the club championships a member must fulfil the following requirements:-
- Members must hold an active CONGU handicap as at the closing date for the competition. Exception: members may play in the Captains' day events without an active CONGU handicap, but cannot win the main prize. Members must hold a competition 'c' CONGU handicap of not more than 28 for men and 36 for ladies as at the closing date for the competition. Exception: Members may play in the Captains' day events without a competition 'c' handicap and/or a handicap above 28 for men, 36 for ladies, but cannot win the main prize.
 - In the event of a player not meeting the above requirements, he/she will be disqualified, but in a pairs competition a single player may represent the pair.
 - New members joining from another golf club with a bona fide handicap certificate may enter, provided they can prove they have met the qualifying requirements (see 17a) at their previous club.
 - A 7 day member who converts to 5 day membership during the course of the competition will be allowed to complete the competition, providing a green fee is paid if the match is played at a weekend.
 - Five day members may only enter The McMullan Seddon, The Laura Davies and Captains' Day Competitions.
 - The handicap allowance will be set by the Competitions Committee.
 - All finals, and all rounds of the McMullan Seddon, will be played from the relevant plate position, not the tee blocks of the day.
18. The following instances **WILL NOT** count as a qualifying round: -
- Cancellation of a competition by the Competition Organiser or New Lane Leisure
 - Failure to submit a correctly completed card signed and returned on time (see rule 16e)
 - Failure to play because of a buggy / trolley ban.
19. a) All entry fees **MUST BE PAID** by the due date. Failure to pay by the due date will result in **NO ENTRY**. Reminders will be posted.
b) Once a draw has been made and published, alterations to the draw sheet may only be made by the Competition Organiser.
20. a) In knockout competitions, it is the responsibility of BOTH players or pairs to arrange a mutually convenient date for the match, offering at least **4 dates of which 3 must be weekend dates**. In the event of an individual or pair being unable to play within the published Competition dates, they are, through courtesy, to concede the match.
In the McMullan/Seddon 3 of those dates must be weekdays.
b) If one or other of the player/pair has difficulty in arranging a mutually agreed date, the competition organiser should be contacted. In the event that neither party has contacted the organiser, and the play-by date has passed, **BOTH WILL BE DISQUALIFIED**
c) Under no circumstance will there be any individual/team extensions of the published dates/times. However the Competition Organiser reserve the right to extend the published dates/times for the competition as a whole (due to bad weather etc.)
21. If you are playing a match, knowing that you cannot play in the subsequent round, you must through courtesy concede the match. In the case of a semi-final or final, the Competition Organiser will consider any exceptional circumstances that affect the timescale as published.
22. **In case of a tie the following procedure will apply:**
- In the event of a tie for first place in any **STROKE PLAY** "scratch" competition those tied will play a further three extra holes stroke play (16th, 17th & 18th), thereafter - sudden death down 16th, 17th & 18th until a result is achieved.
 - In the McMullan Seddon Competition, if there is a tie on the 18th, a further 3 extra holes (1st, 2nd, & 3rd) should be played, thereafter sudden death until a result is achieved.
 - In any other competition for first, second and third place, the result will be decided by a count back on the last 18 holes, then the last 9, 6, 3, 2, and 1 holes, in that order. If a tie still exists, the prize will be shared.
 - In a match play competition any match that is all square on completion of the final hole will continue on a sudden death basis starting at the 1st, then 2nd, 3rd, etc until a result is achieved.
